He told the Daily Mail Online he used a new procedure called AuraLyft.

Dr Talei said: '(It) is a modification of older procedures. What we did, instead of pulling the muscle, tightening the muscle, we made it a muscle release procedure.

'Instead of using the skin as your primary focus you focus on the muscle and the fat and you go in between muscle areas, the deep plain, and you release all the ligaments, the connections, that have formed over time.

'Once it's released you can re-suspend them to where they were 20 years ago and you can do this with zero tension, zero unnatural appearance, zero stretch, zero pull. But the movement you get in the face is huge.'





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
